

Residential System Design Preparatory Questions

- 1. Where does your water come from? Is it from the town water supply, a pump, a bore, or another source?
- 2. What volume of water do you need and at what pressure? We can recommend a water pressure/volume tester to help determine this.
- 3. Where will the irrigation system be installed? Is it for a domestic property, a rural residential property, a rural farm, or a commercial property? If it's on a waterfront property, do you have the necessary permits and licenses?
- 4. Do we need to visit the site to measure and assess the work? If so, there may be a fee that is waived if you decide to proceed with the job. Do you have any plans, such as a site plan, section 32, building plan, or architectural drawings? Can you provide us with a scale plan?
- 5. Where are all the services and subsurface infrastructure located, especially the water mains if TWS is the main water supply?
- 6. Do you have any existing irrigation or plantings pipework infrastructure that we need to consider?
- 7. What type of irrigation do you need? Is it for lawns, gardens, individual plantings, or light commercial use?
- 8. What kind of customer are you? Do you have an account, will you be paying by cash or card, are you a commercial or trade customer, etc?
- 9. Do you want the system to be automated? If so, do you want it to be wireless, remote, WiFi, or manual?
- 10. Do you have power available for the requested pump and controller(s) if required?
- 11. Do you want an estimate of the costs of running the system, including power and town water supply costs?
- 12. Please provide us with your name and address, etc.
- 13. What payment options do you prefer?
- 14. What installation type do you want? Do you want to purchase only the goods, receive a plan only (which incurs a charge), have us do a full supply and install, have a subcontractor install the system, or work with a supply account installer?
